procedure of the various roles involved and the legal process.

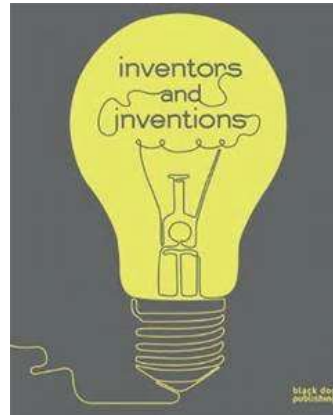
Session #4

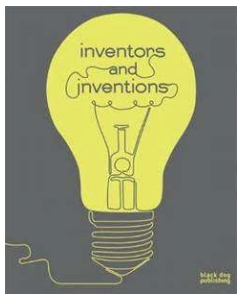
Math Magic (Ages 9-12)
